As part of the academy’s value proposition, courses include an instructor-written student handbook, DJ headphones or a textbook, audio CDs, a t-shirt, and a Certificate of Achievement, in addition to music and equipment purchasing advice.

To accommodate students who do not live in the Boston area but still want to earn the certificate, the academy will also offer this program in accelerated multi-day timeframes through its Mobile DJ Mix Academy. Students can complete the coursework portion of the certificate program and continue working on the remaining parts. “Our students come from all over” said Peter Souhleris, Co-Founder of the DJ Mix Academy, “and we want to remain as flexible as we can to accommodate their changing schedules.”

“By offering more than just the “know-how,” the certificate program also addresses the “can-do” aspect of DJ’ing, for example, through the creation of their own mix CD that students can include as part of their portfolios” said Paul Dailey, Lead Instructor at the academy.
